This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, how we use them, and how you can control them.

### 1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device when you visit a website. They store information that can be retrieved later, enabling websites to remember actions or preferences over time. Cookies are widely used to make websites work efficiently and provide better user experience.

There are different types of cookies based on their purpose and functionality, including first-party cookies (set by the website you're visiting) and third-party cookies (set by other services or platforms).

### 2. Why Do We Use Cookies?

We use cookies for several purposes:

- **To ensure website functionality:** Some cookies are necessary for the basic operation of the Website.
- **To analyze website performance:** We use cookies to understand how visitors interact with our website, which helps us improve performance and user experience.
- **To offer personalized content and advertisements:** Cookies help us tailor content, offers, and advertisements based on your preferences.
- **To enhance user experience:** Cookies allow us to remember your preferences, such as language and region, to make your experience more personalized.



## 3. Types of Cookies We Use

### a. Essential Cookies

#### Examples:

- Session cookies to maintain login status.
- Cookies that save user preferences such as language or location.

### b. Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies collect data on how users interact with our website, such as which pages are visited most often and whether users encounter any errors. These cookies help us improve the overall performance and functionality of our website.

#### Examples:

- Google Analytics cookies to track Website usage data.
- Cookies that measure Website speed.

### c. Functional Cookies

These cookies allow the Website to remember your preferences (such as your username or language choice) and provide enhanced features and personalized content.

#### Examples:

- Cookies that store language preferences.
- Cookies that remember the items added to a shopping cart.

### d. Advertising and Targeting Cookies

These cookies are used to deliver targeted advertisements based on your interests and browsing behavior. They can also limit the number of times you see an ad and help measure the effectiveness of marketing campaigns.



## Examples:

- Facebook, Google Ads, or other advertising network cookies.

## 4. Legal Basis for Using Cookies

- Strictly necessary cookies are used on the basis of legitimate interest.
- All other cookies (analytics, advertising, functional) are used only with your explicit consent as per applicable data protection laws including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and India's Digital Personal Data Protection Act (DPDPA).

## 5. Third-Party Cookies

In addition to our own cookies, we may use third-party cookies for various purposes, including advertising and analytics. These third-party cookies are set by external services such as Google Analytics, Facebook, and others. We do not control these cookies, and their use is governed by the respective third-party's privacy and cookie policies.

## 6. Cookie Management and Your Choices

This Cookie FAQ document explains how and why cookies and similar technologies are used by BMW TechWorks India to improve and enhance user experience when using our websites.

### 1. What are Cookies and other Tracking Technologies?

Our website uses session and persistent cookies, including first-party cookies set by us and third-party cookies used for analytics, advertising, and related services.



## 5. What if I don't want cookies to be used?

You may reject or disable non-essential cookies. Please note that blocking cookies may affect website functionality, and some features may not work as intended.

## 6. How can I manage or change my cookie preferences?

You can manage your preferences at any time through our Privacy Preference Center or via your browser settings. Strictly necessary cookies remain active.

## 7. Do cookies collect my personal information?

Some cookies may collect information such as IP address, device details, browser data, or browsing behaviour, which may be considered personal data under applicable laws. Essential cookies do not store identifiable personal information.

## 8. How long are cookies stored on my device?

- Session cookies: deleted when you close your browser
- Persistent cookies: stored until deleted or until expiry (Analytics cookies may persist up to 13 months; advertising cookies up to 12 months)

## 9. Do BMW TechWorks India websites use third-party cookies?

Yes. We may use third-party cookies for analytics, advertising, and social media integrations. These cookies are governed by the respective third-party privacy policies.

## 10. Can I withdraw my consent for cookies after I have accepted them?

## Cookies – Website Disclosures

BMW TechWorks India uses cookies and similar technologies to ensure the proper functioning of our website, to analyse website traffic, to enhance user experience, to personalise content where applicable, and to support marketing and social media integrations. - **Performance Cookies**

They help us to know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. If you do not allow these cookies we will not know when you have visited our site, and will not be able to monitor its performance.

- **Targeting Cookies**

These cookies may be set through our site by our advertising partners. They may be used to deliver advertisements that are relevant to you and your interests, both on our website and on other platforms.

These cookies may collect information such as your browser type, device information, IP address, and browsing behaviour. This information may constitute personal data under applicable data protection laws.
